Hello,
I am a County resident and it has come to my attention that is requiring
proof of vaccination for customers It is my understanding that if
customers cannot provide proof of v.a.x. they must wear a mask. (include what
their policy is.
I respectfully request that you refrain from requiring proof of vaccination, proof of a negative test, or require the use of a digital passport in order to do business.
I would like to take this time to remind you that requiring the Covid-19 vaccine violates Federal Law. Covid-19 vaccine, an experimental shot, is not approved by the FDA and is deemed "investigational products" under one of the 346 Emergency Use Authorizations ("EUA") issued by the FDA. All three Covid-19 vaccines are not FDA approved to treat, cure, or prevent any disease at this time. For at least two years, clinical trials will continue before the FDA can consider that these vaccines are safe and effective.
Pursuant to Federal law 21 U.S.C. § 360bbb-3(e)(1)(A)(ii)(III) citizens (both your customers and employees) are legally protected and provided with the option to accept or refuse administration of Covid-19 shot and Covid-19 tests as they are "unapproved products", since both have not been fully tested and approved for use by the FDA.
Under the Nuremberg Code, no citizen within the United States of America may be coerced to participate in this medical experiment.
Within my rights as a citizen, I have the right to be free from unreasonable searches and seizures within the Fourth Amendment of the United States Constitution. Your policy also violates these same rights under Article I § 12 of the New York State constitution. (if you are not from NYS - omit this and include the rights under your state Constitution). Requesting proof of any form of private medical documentation is unacceptable and illegal.
I cannot in good conscience support any business that promotes tyranny, discrinimation, and segregation.
Just know if continues to require proof of vaccination status, I will notify the members in my community and together we will boycott, protest, and picket your business.
I hope that this is just a simple misunderstanding. As a concerned citizen, I understand how much small businesses have struggled during this past year of lockdowns and over breaching use of power by our government. I would like to do my part in supporting

small businesses, but I will not be able to do so if my rights are violated so I'm urging you to do your part in protecting a Free America.
